Setting up new accounts, changing automatic deposits and payments, and closing your old account can sometimes seem tedious. MAKING THE SWITCH IN FIVE SIMPLE STEPS:

1 **Cross over to Cornerstone Bank and open your new accounts.**

Stop in at any one of our Cornerstone Bank Banking Centers to open your account*. Make a note of your routing numbers and account numbers from your former financial institution and Cornerstone Bank, they'll come in handy later.

The bank routing number is the first nine digits of the series printed on the bottom of your checks.

2 **Stop using your old account.**

Let all your checks clear. This could take up to 30 days. During this time, destroy any unused checks, ATM and debit cards and deposit slips. No shredder? Bring them to us and we'll shred them for you.

We understand it can be confusing during this transition period, and we will work closely to ensure accounts are monitored. It is recommended that old accounts remain open for 30 days to allow for all outstanding items to clear.

3 **Change direct deposits.**

Fill out the enclosed form and give it to your employer or the company handling your paychecks or retirement payments. Make sure to include a new deposit slip or voided check. If you have direct deposit of Social Security or another government direct deposit, visit <https://www.ssa.gov/deposit/howtosign.htm> or we'll provide you with the Standard Form 1199A to change the direct deposit.

4 **Change automatic payments.**

Use the enclosed form to change all automatic withdrawals or automated payment services. Don't forget about payments using your old debit card, such as automatic payments made online.

Move your online bill payments to our Free Online Banking and Bill Pay service. Use the enclosed form to remember the online payments you currently have. We can help you enter them into our Free Online Bill Pay.

5 **Close your old accounts.**

Here's the day you have been waiting for. After leaving your accounts open long enough for all outstanding checks and withdrawals to clear, send in the enclosed form to close your old account. If you have a remaining balance, your old bank should send you a check. It's as simple as that.
